Introduction: Dealing with the folks who know you...

[Luke 4:14-28]Rejected by His Homies!	
vs.14-15	Popularity came Jesus' way
vs.16-17	(Capernaum, Galilee had a large Non-Jewish population)
	Luke continues to show that Jesus took the teachings of Judaism seriously
vs.18-19	Isaiah 61:1-2 = The Servant Song
	"anointed me" = "made me the Messiah or Christ"
vs.21	TODAY! God's time is TODAY!
vs.22	Amazed folks!
vs.23	Jesus has ascertained that the people of Nazareth want him to do some kind of miracle
	They have made the mistake of allowing their proximity and familiarity to blind them
vs.24-27	The main thought here is that the citizens of Nazareth should not think
	they're "special" enough to be a part of God's kingdom just because
	they've grown up with Jesus
	Jesus must take the Message to others, where it will be better received
vs.28	People of Nazareth are enraged for two reasons:
	(a.) Misunderstanding of their scriptures and (b.) Jealousy
	(a.)All this time, they've believed that all of God's blessings were
	for them. So they couldn't accept what Jesus had to say. Had
	they understood the scriptures, they would have embraced Jesus
	and his message.
	(b)Even if they didn't understand God's promises in the scripture, why would God send his message and favor to non-jews?
vs.28-30	They try to kill him, but Jesus mysteriously moved through them.
[Luke 4:31-37]Demons Beware!	
vs.34	Demon knows who Jesus is
vs.35	Why does Jesus tell the demon to be quiet before casting it out?
vs.36-37	The Word is out!
